## **Primary PE and Sport Funding**

In 2014/2015 we received £8,602 to support PE and Sport in years 5 and 6.

We have continued to spend this money on:

- Membership of the school sports partnership to offer a range of sporting activities that we could not offer.
- Association fees, replacement of equipment and hire of grounds that set high expectations for our students and demonstrates how much St. Peter's values sports.
- The purchase of medals to encourage participation and reward achievement in sports.

In addition to last year, we have spent this money on:

- Joining the Slough Schools Football Association
  - o Running a football team
  - Transport for events
  - o Fees for the football association
  - Equipment

Mr Imbastari coached the team through their training and matches and they finished the season victorious! They were the winners of the Grenfell Shield Cup – St Peter's first ever final. Throughout the campaign, Mr Imbastari not only coached and mentored them in their physical achievements but also used our school values to ensure that they played with integrity.

As a result of the funding and the opportunities that we continue to provide, we hold the Silver School Kite mark.

'St Peter's Middle School offers its pupils a wealth of opportunities in extra-curricular activities and is committed to engaging all of its pupils in sport and physical activity. There was also evidence of support and signposting of pupils to sports clubs around the area, as well as external sports coaches and wider school staff delivering sessions within the school in a range of sports. Furthermore, data records of pupil engagement in the School Games and school sport activity and the monitoring of this data was at a very high standard. In addition, St Peter's evidenced strong engagement in Levels 1-3 of the School Games and has an impressive level of support for their talented young athletes. St Peter's Middle School met all of the criteria for the Silver award and was only short of reaching the Gold in 3 areas.'

Due to the more varied clubs that we are now able to offer (Ultimate Frisbee being just one of them) we have seen an increase in participation. Greater participation at school clubs has enabled us to offer a wider variety of activities. Over 50% of students regularly attend after school clubs.

We also have County badminton, rugby and cricket players as well as students who compete in the National Schools Equestrian Association competitions.

Achieving success boosts self-confidence as well as fitness. We are proud of our students' achievements.

In 2015/16 we will receive £8, 590. This is based on a lump sum all schools receive of £8000 and then £5 per student. We will use this money to continue the work we are doing and increase the opportunities on offer by widening the opportunities to provide an inclusive PE curriculum and continue to participate in and compete in school sport.
