Year 7 Catch Up Funding Impact Report 16-17 and planned spend for 17- 18

Catch up funding is targeted to support those pupils at KS3 who did not achieve Age Related Expectations at the end of KS2.

Total funding received: £5,228

12 pupils who did not achieve ARE in reading and/or maths at the end of KS2.
