Maths Fractions, Decimals and Percentages

- Multiply fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers
- Read and write decimal numbers as fractions.
- Recognise and use thousandths and relate them to tenths, hundredths and other decimal equivalences
- Solve problems involving multiplication and division by simple fractions and problems involving simple rates (scaling up and scaling down).
- Read, write, order and compare decimal up to three places.
- Round decimals up to two places to the nearest whole number and one decimal place.
