

School Led Tutoring Statement 2021/22

As part of the Department for Education's (DfE)'s education recovery plan, the Secretary of State for Education is providing financial assistance to eligible local authorities, for their maintained schools, and academy trusts. This is in accordance with section 14 of the Education Act 2002, in the form of the school-led tutoring grant for the 2021 to 2022 academic year.

St Peter's Middle school will use the grant initially to support children who are eligible for pupil premium and who would benefit from further support from 1:1, 1:2 or small group tuition.

Sessions will be delivered before and after school, where possible, with sessions also being offered in the school day. Where this is the case, the timetable will be carefully organised so the children do not miss out on other curriculum opportunities. The sessions will focus on core skills in reading, writing and maths across KS2 and KS3.

Students will be assessed at the end of each full term and the attainment and progress of these pupil groups will be shared with the school's governing body.

This will continue into the 2022 – 23 academic year, using the same model.
